What is the school's approach to learning? How is student performance measured? Is there a lot of learning expected at home?
What opportunities are available for my child? What types of co-curriculars (performing arts, athletics, ASAs, clubs, etc.) are available? What off-campus opportunities are available? How can my child pursue his/her specialized interests?
What type of student support does the school offer? Is there support for English language learners or children with specific learning needs? What language do the students learn in? Is there a dual language program? Does theschool have academic and emotional counseling? How does the school prepare my child for university or the next step of their choice?
How do the school's facilities influence my child's learning? Can we access the facilities outside of school hours?
What are the school's health, safety, and child protection policies and procedures?
Does the school have diversity, equity and inclusion policies?
How does the school communicate with parents and how will I be able to communicate with the school?
Are there opportunities as a parent to participate?
Is there space for all of my children?
